For remote opening of gates etc.



Functions and application

A radio key in combination with a radio receiver can be used to remotely open doors and/ or control relays (C17). Radio receivers are available in C18, A61 and A66 (Stand -alone and VAKA)

Radio keys



- Radio key for C18, A66 and A61 with one or four buttons.
- The radio keys have unique identities and is connected to persons in VAKA the same way as a card or tag. The radio keys can be time sensitive, black listed or given access to different doors.
- Elegant design with sliding cover to prevent accidental button presses.
- The communication between radio keys and receivers is encrypted to provide high protection against interception.
- Range depending on surroundings (5-100 m).

The readers A66 and A61 have receivers for Axema's radio keys

C18 Radio Module



- C18 is a plug in module with built in radio receiver for B27. The radio receiver allows gates and doors to be opened remotely, for example, without stopping or getting out of a car.
- With C18 and external antenna, 100 m reading distance can be accomplished, which results in convenient gate openings before the car has arrived.
- C18 and RN18-4 can be configured to open different doors or control relays (C17) in the VAKA system using different buttons.

Attributes

Wall mounted antenna for C18



- External antenna with 3 m cable, designed to be mounted on a wall outside.
- Improves range.
